1099-S FILING SEASON



The filing season for 1099-S FORMS is fast approaching.

The Form 1099-S, along with the appropriate Form 1096 transmittal, must be submitted to the Internal Revenue Service no later than February 28, 2024, if filing on paper, or by April 1, 2024, if filing electronically.

As you know, the IRS has reduced the e-filing threshold from 250 forms per year to only **10 forms** per year. If you have not yet reviewed the IRS materials on this topic, please refer to our <u>Agent Alert</u>.

*For Paper Document Reporting, all forms must be prepared in accordance with IRS guidelines. Do not cut or separate Copies A of the triplicate form. Do not staple, tear, tape or photocopy any forms. Please remember the IRS DOES NOT ACCEPT SUBSTITUTE FORM 1099-S filings. (See Paragraph G of the 2023 General Instructions for Certain Returns for more detailed information.) If you choose to give a substitute form to the Transferor, it must comply with Pub. 1179.
